

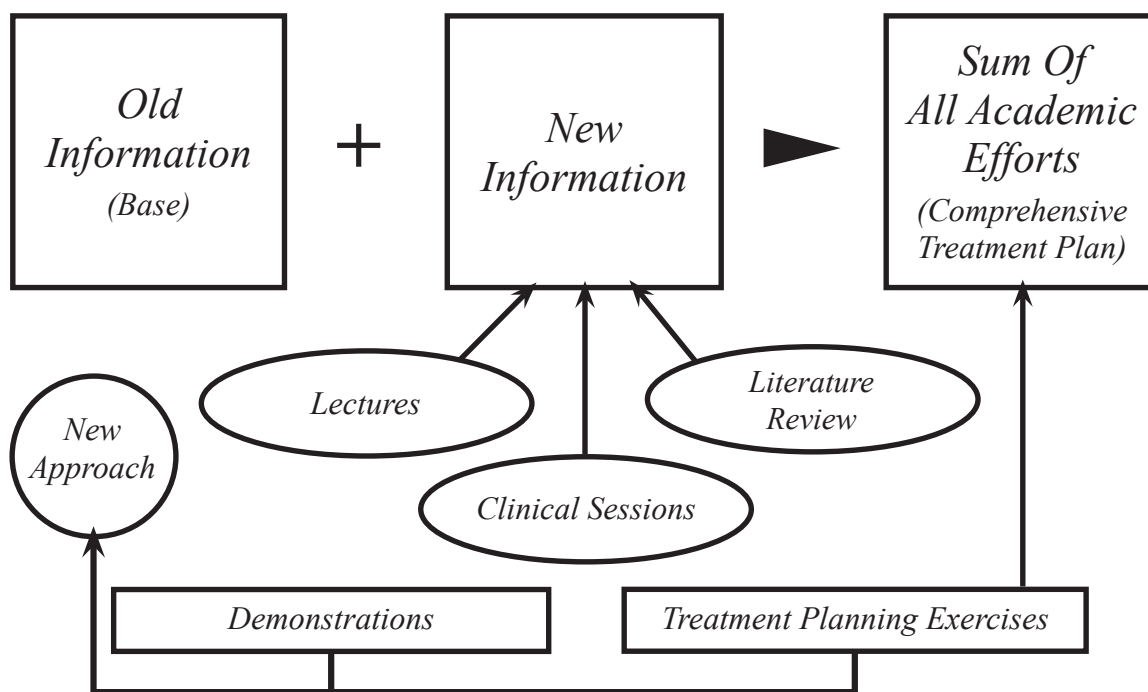

## Curriculum Development

As a result of his experience in his own club, Dr. Cohen came to understand that traditional study clubs are based on an outdated educational modality. Specifically, that clinical knowledge is best enhanced through lectures.

We know today, however, that there needs to be application sessions where we can practice and test the levels of our knowledge. We need to find educational methods that allow us to become comfortable with the treatment techniques and options we are learning.



Only then are we able to effectively utilize our academic efforts in creating ideal treatment plans. The Seattle Study Club is based on this type of educational model, allowing us to add to our existing knowledge base in a variety of effective ways. This is a synergistic approach in which the whole is greater than the sum of its parts, creating a curriculum that moves the practitioner forward in a predictable and effective manner.

The Seattle Study Club program is set on an academic calendar – one program per month from September through May or June. This grad school type curriculum is designed to take the general practitioner synergistically from point A to point B during the course of the year. Application sessions are designed to test the participants' knowledge and allow them to expand their comfort zone regarding diagnosis and treatment planning. A typical program will consist of 6–7 clinical/interactive sessions and 2–3 one-day lectures which support the clinical session
